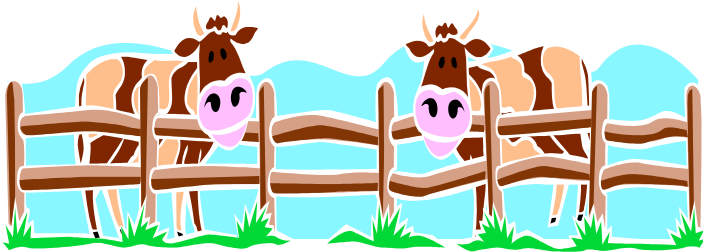

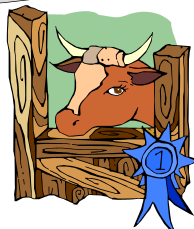

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Johne's Disease** – Exhibitors **MUST** have a signed Health Declaration that to their knowledge their cattle have not been in contact with any stock which have originated from a property **which is known to have been infected with Johne's Disease, and are required to declare that Johne's Disease is not known or suspected to have occurred in the past five (5) years on the property from which the cattle have come.** *(Please bring you own drinking vessels to prevent problems.)*
2. The age of cattle to be the actual age up to and including 11th February, 2012.
3. No exhibits to compete in more than one class, except where otherwise stated.
4. Exhibits must be registered or be eligible for registration on their respective stud books, led steer excepted.
5. All exhibits must be true to type and in the opinion of the judge worthy of a prize.
6. All exhibits must be paraded in the judging ring.
7. Junior Champions are permitted to compete for Grand Championships.
8. Stud grooms are requested to wear dust coats/appropriate breed dress.
9. In case of more than 10 entries in a class, the committee reserves the right to divide the class.
10. An exhibit must at all times be provided with a strong halter and be thoroughly broken to lead.
11. A bull, 12 months of age and over, must at all times have a nose ring and at all times be led by a halter and nose lead. The nose lead must be affixed to the ring.
12. Any bulls 8-12 months of age must have a bulldog clip or a nose ring – under 8 months exempt.
13. All steers must at all times have a nose ring or bulldog clip.
14. An exhibit shall be securely tied up both by an effective neck rope or collar and halter at all times whilst in a cattle shed and not under the immediate and effective control of an attendant.
15. All females to be shown with nose grip.
16. Breeds not listed will be catered for, if required.
17. The Committee reserves the right to restrict entries.
18. Proof of age may be required, i.e. registration may be requested.
19. Calves paraded with mother not to be older than 8 months, and the date of birth to be shown on entry form.
20. All stock to be NLIS tagged and presented for scanning as required.
21. Perpetual Trophies –
 - a) The Ironbark Pastoral Co. Trophy for the Supreme Champion Bull
 - b) The Newstead South Pastoral Co. Trophy for the Supreme Champion Cow
 - c) The F H Kneipp (Dundee) Trophy for two beef bulls of any breed, not to be judged as a pair. Bred and owned by the exhibitor
 - d) The R D & F E Kneipp, Echo Park Stud Trophy for the best three (3) animals – both sexes to be represented. Bred and owned by the exhibitor.
 - e) The Marge & Late Owen Curtis Trophy for the Grand Champion Hereford Bull.
 - f) The D F & J C Kneipp Trophy for Champion Pure Bred Led Steer.
 - g) The Battalion Hereford Trophy for Supreme Beast of Show

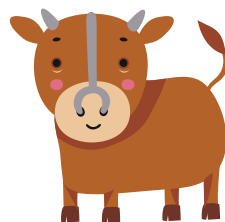

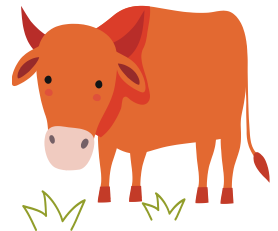
