Conditions of entry:

- All work must be the original work of the exhibitor
 - All articles must have been completed in the last twelve (12) months
 - Each plate to be accompanied with an appropriate stand
 - Each entry to show – Name, Address and Class. This also to be stated on the entry form
 - All transport costs and insurance to be met by the exhibitor
 - The committee will exercise every care with works submitted, but will not be held responsible for the loss of, or damage to any work while in its custody
 - The stewards reserve the right to disqualify an entry not complying with the conditions.
 - The decision of the judge will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding such decisions
1. Any exhibit featuring any of the following – pen, wash, lustre enamels, raised paste, petit point, texture, metallics, grounding, etching, gold, silver
 2. Floral, any of Class 1 can be incorporated
 3. Bird/s and or animal/s, any of Class 1 can be incorporated
 4. Miniature piece not to exceed 7cm, any of Class 1 can be incorporated
 5. Open or any other work not included in the above including Glass but any of Class 1 can be incorporated
