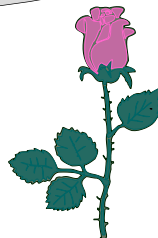

### ROSES

1. 1 White Rose
2. 1 Red Rose
3. 1 Pink Rose
4. 1 Yellow Rose
5. 1 Rose – any other colour
6. Bud to Full Bloom in three (3) stages – not necessarily 3 cuts
7. One Fully Blown Rose – showing stamens
8. 1 cut Floribunda Rose – 4 or more blooms
9. Container of Roses – decorative, 7 blooms, 2 distinct colours or more
10. Container of Roses – decorative, 5 blooms, 1 colour
11. 1 cut Miniature Rose
12. Vase of Miniature Roses, any colour
13. Bowl of mixed Roses (A bowl is any container wider than high and is not provided by the stewards)

### DAHLIAS

- Dahlias judged strictly to RHS rules
  - Dahlias under 160mm must be staged 3 blooms per vase to be eligible for a Championship Award
