Conditions of Entry

- Please check lids are not contaminated with previous contents
- Exhibits to be delivered to the pavilion (with stickers attached) before 9am, Thursday 9th February.
- Society stickers supplied to exhibitors have a large part with a small section. The small section goes on the lid the large part goes on the reverse side of the jar to where the name of the jam is
- Labels to be 4cm from the top of all jars in all classes
- All exhibits in this section must be the bona-fide production of the person in whose name the exhibits are entered
- Exhibitors are advised that all jams and jellies are to be shown in screw top jars, approx., 400g (1/2 pound) jar to be used (peanut butter jar size). Please have name of jam etc., on bottle, and suggest, for added attraction, that all tops be plain white or metallic (no advertisements).
- Sauces to be in tall bottles
- Jam has fruit in small pieces
- Conserve has fruit mostly still whole
- Jelly is crystal clear, no fruit
- Please check all entries for mould
- No prize will be awarded unless the judge thinks it worthy
- No late entries will be accepted after 9am on day of judging
- **Perpetual Trophies to be returned to Secretary's Office prior to 2013 Show**

Judges Tips

- ◇ Clean jars for exhibition with windex or methylated spirits
- ◇ Use fresh fruit ONLY – no dried fruit, apricots etc
- ◇ Contents to be filled to the neck of jar, approx., 1cm from the top
- ◇ Let jams stand before bottling to avoid bubbles
- ◇ Lids not to show advertisements
- ◇ When a collection is entered, jars must be identical

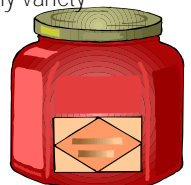
