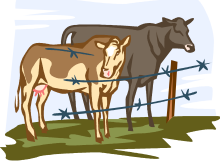

PENNING UP AND JUDGING TIMES

Hoof Classes (1-4A) must be penned by 9am on Friday 10th.

Judging will commence at 1.30pm Friday.

Commercial Classes (5-7) must be penned by 9am on Saturday 11th.

Judging will commence at 1.00pm. Saturday.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Johne's Disease – Exhibitors are required to have a signed Health Declaration that to their knowledge their cattle have not been in contact with any stock which have originated from a property which is known to have been infected with Johne's Disease. Exhibitors are required to declare that Johne's Disease is not known or suspected to have occurred in the past five (5) years on the property from which the cattle have come.

NLIS Identification – All stock MUST be fitted with a NLIS device before leaving the property.

- The exhibitor must have owned all entries for at least three (3) months prior to the competition.
- All entries in the hoof classes must be naturally polled, de horned or tipped.
- Cattle may be purebred or crossbred of any breed combinations.
- All entries will be judged in the Judging Ring.
- No exhibit to compete in more than one class unless otherwise specified.
- **It is the owner's responsibility to feed and water the exhibit whilst on the showground.**
- Entries will be mouthed, weighed and numbered. Electronic scales will be used for weighing.
- The judges in making their decision will take into consideration weight for age, conformation, muscling, absence of wasteful fat, market suitability and in the case of pens the uniformity of the pen in weight and type.
- The committee reserves the right to restrict or refuse entries if necessary.

1. Pen of Three Feedlot Steers suitable for short feed. (100 to 150 days)

- Specifications:
- Approximate Age: milk to 2 tooth
 - Muscle Score: C or better
 - Approx. Entry Live Weight: 350 to 480kg
 - Approximate Rib Fat: 0 to 8 (approx fat score 2 to 2+)
- Target Carcase Specifications:
- Carcase Weight: 300 to 400kg after 100 to 150 days on feed
 - Fat P8 site: 7 to 22mm

2. Trade Heifer Class

- Approximate Age: Milk to 2 tooth

 - Group to be judged on conformation & quality as a commercial group showing breeding potential

6. Breeding Heifer (Heifer & First Calf)

- Specifications:
- Any Breed or Cross
 - Showing no more than 6 permanent teeth
 - Calf at foot not to exceed 8 months
 - Group to be judged on conformation & quality as a commercial group showing breeding potential

7. Commercial Breeders Group (Cow & Calf and Replacement Heifer)

- Specifications:
- Any Breed or Cross
 - Cow with suckling steer or heifer calf at foot, and a replacement heifer of any breed or cross
 - Calf at foot not to exceed 8 months of age
 - Replacement heifers showing no more than 2 permanent teeth
 - Group to be judged on conformation & quality and as a productive commercial unit showing breeding potential
