Conditions of Entry:

- **All ceramics must be incised with maker's name, initials or special mark and date. This must be covered with tape during judging**
- All work should be the work of the contestant
- Ceramics made in seminars are not acceptable for competition
- All entries must have been completed in the last twelve (12) months
- All care will be taken in handling of ceramics, but insurance responsibility rests with the entrant
- Ceramics will be divided into –
Novice – A person who has been making ceramics for less than 12 months
Advanced – A person who has been making ceramics for more than 12 months
Advanced Professional – A person who teaches ceramics or who sells their works for a profit
- The decision of the Judge will be final
- The Stewards reserve the right to disqualify any entry not complying with these conditions
